Barbara Szumanska from the EAL service will be in the Nursery every Wednesday to support children with English as an Additional Language. Barbara is a fluent Polish speaker and additionally can speak some Russian. She is also available for translation if parents need assistance in speaking with staff.

Reminders

Toys from Home: A lot of children have been bringing toys into the nursery from home. Can we please remind you to encourage your child to keep these in their bag or not to bring them at all — they can get lost or broken and we have plenty of toys in Nursery already!

We will be starting weekly 'Show And Tell' for the children to bring in something they would like to share from home. Keep an eye on the nursery boards for when this will be happening.

Snack: We have been noticing that some of the children have said they have not had breakfast or lunch before they arrive for their nursery session and are very hungry. Nursery snack is sadly not substantial enough to replace a meal for the children and we would encourage you to try to ensure your child has eaten something before they come to nursery.

Security: Please can you ensure you write the correct adult on the collection section of the sign-in/out sheet. If you are unsure exactly who will be picking your child up, please put down all possibilities. Additionally, if your circumstances change and someone else will be picking up your child, please call the nursery to inform us. This will avoid any unnecessary confusion or delay at the end of the session.

Toilets: For child protection reasons, please use only the disabled toilet area for changing or accompanying your child to the toilet.

Parents/Carers are not permitted in the children's toilet area.

Please keep an eye on the main nursery door, notice boards and the letter trays in the cloakroom for information and important letters. We would hate for you to miss anything!
