You will notice that we are now having some of the parent council meetings in the evening, this will ensure that working parents are not excluding from supporting the parent council.

The Parent Council shared with the school that it can be difficult to find time to do homework with children on weekdays. In order to support parents with this every class will now issue formal homework on a Wednesday with an expectation that it is returned on a Monday, therefore allowing children the chance to do their homework at the weekend. Reading homework will continue to be issued on during the week. We hope that this change will help support you to ensure your child's homework is completed.

Free School Meals – Primary 4 – Primary 7

If your child receives free school meals you are required to renew their entitlement to this each year, if you have not done this since we returned in August then this is now. The office has contacted many parents to advise them of this but several have not responded. If you do not renew this you will begin to be charged for your child's school meals. To renew please contact the office and they will be able to assist you.

Staff news

We are delighted to welcome Mr Stuart Probart to Riverbank School, Mr Probart will be teaching P6S on a Tuesday and will cover planning time in nearly every other class in the school – so all the children will get to know him guickly.

We are also able to share with you that Mrs Michelle Howarth will be joining the Primary 1 teachers on Monday 5th of November. Mrs Howarth is an Early Years Practioner and she will be working with the Primary 1 teachers to promote play based learning in Primary 1. We have been able to employ Miss Howarth due to the additional funding provided by the Scottish Government through the Scottish Attainment Challenge.

We will also welcome Mr Nuno Duarte to the teaching staff, Mr Duarte will be teaching in P2WS (Monday – Wednesday) and will support in other early stages classes for the remainder of the week.

During the October holidays Miss Gardner and Miss Sutherland got married and they are changing their surnames. Miss Gardner is now Mrs McGregor and Miss Sutherland is now Mrs Campbell.

Christmas Events

All of the children from P1-P7 will have the opportunity to join us on a trip to HMT to see the pantomime on Wednesday 13th of December – more information will follow nearer the time. This booking has meant we have had to change the dates of the Christmas parties as this was due to be the P1 party. Each year group party has moved on one day – the new dates are at the top of the newsletter.

Facebook

We are currently creating a Riverbank Information Page on Facebook; this will allow us to post the newsletter and other information on Facebook. In line with Aberdeen City Council's policy on social media you will not be able to freely post on this page and any post requests will be viewed by school staff before being posted.

We hope that this will ensure that parents are able to view the most up to date information. At the moment we offer the newsletter in a variety of ways (Email, school website and paper copies can be collected from the office) but this will mean a wider audience will be able to view the information. We will let you know when this page will be operational.

Class Dojo, Reward schemes & House Points

Every class teacher operates a 'reward' system in their class. Some of the teachers use Class Dojo and others may use a points system, sticker charts, and marbles in a jar to name a few. These are individual to each class and we have asked the teacher's to share with you their individual class reward system.

We also have a whole school approach which is the use of House Points. Every child in the school is placed in a House (these are Seaton, Kings, St Machar & Hayton) and they earn house points by meeting specific targets (these are created by the House Captains) and by following the school and class charter. The House points are collated and at the end of each term and the winning house gets an extra-long play time. At the end of the school session the winning house for the session went on a cinema trip.
