P1-P7 Trip to HMT

You will be now have received the information regarding our trip to HMT on Wednesday 13th of December. We should return to the school at 4.45 pm, please ensure you arrive at the school promptly to collect your children. For safety reasons all children will be collected from their classrooms. If we are going to be back at school after 5.00 pm I will send a text to parents advising them of this.

Any children not going to the pantomime should attend school as normal; they will have the early lunch with all the other children and will remain in school with Mrs Smith undertaking other activities. At 3.15 pm these children will be dismissed from the school office (P1-P3 children must be collected by an adult).

The children have decided they would like to celebrate Christmas Jumper Day at Riverbank on Friday 22nd of December – we will ask the children to pay £1 and all monies raised will be donated to Save the Children.
