Sharing Assemblies

Chickenpox / Sickness bug

We have had a spate of children with illnesses recently, the two most common have been chickenpox and a sickness / diarrhoea bug.

If your child has chickenpox the NHS policy is that the children should remain off school until 5 days after the spots have appeared, but may be longer if your child still has a fever.

If your child vomits or has diarrhoea then they must stay off school for at least 48 hours after the last 'incident' of sickness or diarrhoea.

These policies are in place to ensure that children are well enough to attend school and that other children and staff are not unnecessarily exposed to illnesses.

Spare Clothing

We currently have very little 'spare' clothing in school for when a child has an 'accident'. If your child has previously come home with school clothes can you please return these. For younger children in particular it would be helpful if you put spare clothing for your child in a bag to be kept in school. If anyone has underwear or skirts / trousers their children have outgrown then we would happily receive donations for this.

Dropping off / collecting children

We have recently become aware that a small amount of parents are using the parking area between Aberdeen Lads Club and the School to drive through and drop off / collect children. This is a restricted area and should not be used for this purpose. We ask that parents respect this in the interest of the health and safety of all the children and adults.
