## **School Lunch Times / Home Lunches**

You may remember that we consulted with staff, parents and pupils regarding the lunch times and the situation regarding home lunches. In response to this consultation we will be making some changes next session. From August 2018 our lunch times will be:

12.00 – 1.00 Primary 1 & Primary 2 12.30 – 1.30 Primary 5, Primary 6 & Primary 7 1.00 – 2.00 Primary 3 & Primary 4

We will trial this until the end of December when will then review the situation.

Due to an increase in incidents involving our children within the community at lunchtime, we also consulted with parents, pupils and staff regarding 'Home' Lunches. We also discussed this with the other schools in the area and based on this we are making a change to the arrangements for children going out at lunchtime.

From August 2018, all children from Primary 1 – Primary 7 will need to be signed out by a parent at lunchtime if they wish for them to go home. The parent will need come to the office to meet the child at their allotted lunch time where they will then 'sign' for them. Children will no longer be permitted to go 'out' for lunch unless accompanied by an adult.
