### **Head Lice**

A number of children throughout the school are continually catching head lice. Could I ask that all of you check your children's hair regularly for infestations? Please remember to check all family members – many children catch lice at home from adults who are unaware they have lice because they are not itchy.

If you find live lice treatment and advice is available free through your GP, health visitor or pharmacist.

Children should not stay off school if they have head lice but it should be treated as quickly as possible.
