ACC – Unacceptable Actions Policy

Aberdeen City Council has an Unacceptable Actions Policy which clearly states how members of the public should behave towards members of staff.

- Unreasonable demands:

Staff will end a meeting or a telephone conversation if they feel that an adult is behaving in this way.
