Head Lice

Head Lice is an ongoing issue at most Primary Schools, and we would like to remind parents of what they should do if they realise that their child has head lice. It is really important that you check your child's head regularly and that you treat with Head Lice chemicals which are available from any pharmacy. Once you have treated your child it is vitally important that you continue to check

and 'comb' on a daily basis for at least 2 weeks after the treatment. The treatment will kill live lice but will not kill the unhatched eggs, therefore continuing to comb and remove these and any live lice for at least 2 weeks is vital. Children should **not** stay off school if they have head lice. Hopefully if parents remain vigilant then we can minimise the impact this has on the children.

Sports Day – Tuesday 4th June (weather permitting) or Tuesday 11th of June

Our annual P1 to P7 sports is on Tuesday 4th of June (times detailed below), if due to poor weather the sports do not go ahead on the 4th then we will have the sports on the 11th of June.
