## Additional In-Service Days

Next session we are to have 2 additional In-Service days – Aberdeen City Council have decided that these will be on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> of August and Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> of November. This is the case in all Aberdeen City schools.
