Pupil Flu Vaccinations

The NHS team will be in school on Wednesday 9th of December to deliver the flu vaccinations to pupils. This will only be administered to children who have parental permission.

Christmas Jumper Day / Christmas Lunch

Friday 11th of December is our Christmas Lunch and Christmas jumper day – the children can come to school wearing their favourite Christmas Jumper and we thoroughly enjoy seeing the home-made creations. Christmas lunch will be served in the dining room but if your child prefers, they can bring a packed lunch

P1 & P2, 3 & 4 Christmas Sharing Event

On Monday 14th December at 2.00 pm the P1 children will share with you their Christmas Event – again this will be on google classroom. And on Tuesday 15th December at 2.00 pm the P2, 3 & 4 children will be online to share their Christmas Celebrations with you.

Christmas Fun Day

On Thursday 17th December, the whole school will have a Christmas Fun Day, this will involve the children watching the Virtual Pantomime in the morning and having their party. The school will provide the class with party foods (individually wrapped) and the class will plan their party to include games and activities that are Covid safe. Normally all the children in a year group would get together for the party but this year the party will be held in each individual class.

Christmas Cards

This year unfortunately children and staff will not be able to share Christmas Cards in school. Each class will have their own way of sharing Christmas Greetings (i.e. a paper Christmas Tree display and each child makes a bobble in school to share with each other).

Staff Christmas Gifts

In previous years, some children / parents have purchased a Christmas Gift for members of staff, which we are always very grateful for. Due to Covid we are not able to accept these this year. We would ask instead that you donate to a local food bank, who I am sure will be more than happy to accept these.

Face Coverings

As you are aware, Scottish Government guidance is that parents now need to wear face coverings when dropping off children and collecting. This applies whether parents enter the school building or not. Please remember that a small minority of parents may have exemption and will not be able to wear a face covering. .

One-way system

We continue to operate the one-way system in the playground for adults, we ask that you respect this at all times.
