Measures in place will continue to include:

- High standards of hygiene, including regular handwashing and sanitising throughout the school day
- 2m social distancing between adults and between primary children and adults
- Keep left system for moving around the school
- All adults will wear a face mask (unless exempt) if they cannot maintain 2m social distancing
- All parents should wear a face covering when on school grounds (unless exempt) and follow 2m social distancing guidance
- Social distancing between classes in the dining hall
- Parents to wear face coverings in and around the school playground and to maintain 2m social distancing from each other
