### Letter from Mrs Ironside



#### Hello all.

We are delighted that we will now be able to welcome the P4-P7 children back to school on Monday 15th of March.

Below are details of how the return will work but we have kept routines the same as December to avoid confusion. One of the main points I want to highlight is that it is essential that all families follow safety guidance at drop off and pick up times.

Families must maintain 2m from anyone who is not in their household bubble. Mixing of adults presents a significant risk to the school community so we ask for your support to ensure that everyone continues to follow Scottish Government safety advice. We also ask that siblings do not accompany the children to school if at all possible and that only one adult comes in to the playground for drop off and pick up. As before only nursery, P1, P2 and P3 parents can access the playground. No P4-P7 parent should be in within the school playground.

We will continue to operate the one way system in the playground and adults must wear a face covering when dropping off and picking up. Members of the Senior Management Team will be in the playground to offer support and reminders, please do not be offended if you are approached regarding this as we are doing our best to keep everyone safe.. Please alert them if you have any concerns.

Thank you for your continued support as we work together to ensure the best for the Riverbank Community.



## **School Lunches**



Normal school lunch service will be in place from Monday 15th March. The menu is available on Aberdeen City Council's website. Children have the option of taking a packed lunch to school but cannot be collected for a home lunch.

### What to take to school



Please send your children to school in warm, waterproof clothing. Despite the weather, Outdoor Learning will play a large part in the return curriculum and, unless extreme conditions, children will be outside at break and lunchtimes.

Children should take as little to school as possible, all stationery and resources will be provided for them. Every child should bring a water bottle with them to school as we are not allowed to use shared cups. The children will be encouraged to drink throughout the day and to refill their bottles regularly.

As children may be wearing boots / wellies outside, they may bring a pair of gym shoes to change in to but these must be taken home with them each day.

Children should bring a snack with them for break time, as before the children have to take all wrappings etc home with them so it may be a good idea to give them a small bag for this purpose.

### How we are keeping everyone safe.



#### Measures in place will continue to include:

- High standards of hygiene, including regular handwashing and sanitising throughout the school day
- 2m social distancing between adults and between primary children and adults
- Keep left system for moving around the school
- All adults will wear a face mask (unless exempt) if they cannot maintain 2m social distancing
- All parents should wear a face covering when on school grounds (unless exempt) and follow 2m social distancing guidance
- Social distancing between classes in the dining hall
- Classes will be in zones for break and lunch times to prevent mixing
- Windows will be open to support increased ventilation. School staff will monitor temperatures to ensure it doesn't get too cold
- Resources will be cleaned regularly and there will be limited sharing
- New Measure: All school staff have been offered twice weekly testing
