With works for the new Riverbank Primary School underway, we want to keep you informed about our progress so far and what we'll be doing in the months ahead.

Our progress to date

We took possession of the new Riverbank Primary School site on 15th May 2023. We have established our site accommodation and set up CCTV cameras around the perimeter of the site. We have also been working closely with Aberdeen City Council and the project design team to have the CLT (Cross Laminated Timber) frame designed. The CLT frame will be manufactured in Austria.

We have also been working closely with our Supply Chain and have made a large number of contract appointments for the delivery of the project, which is going to involve the co-ordination and management of 76 different work packages.

Some external works activities have progressed on site, including the installation of our on-site temporary car park, and the installation of service ductwork throughout the site area.

What to expect in the coming months (Oct – Nov)

- Temporary Water Connection works.
- Electric substation installation works.
- Cleaning of the existing Concrete Ground Floor Slab.
- Access works at the Northeast end of the site.
- Site sign notice board to be erected on site.
- Commencement of Structural Frame Manufacture off site.
- Commencement of Structural Frame Installation on site.

Partial Footpath closure between Coningham Gardens and Harris Drive

Hunter Construction Ltd are scheduled to commence the installation of the new Cruyff Court Willie Miller on Formartine Road in October 2023 with completion currently forecast for Spring 2024.

During the construction of the Cruyff Court Willie Miller there will be partial closure of a footpath between Coningham Gardens and Harris Drive.

The diversion will be signposted.
