With works for the new Riverbank Primary School underway, we want to keep you informed about our progress so far and what we will be doing in the months ahead.

Our progress to date

We secured possession of the new Riverbank Primary School site on 15th May 2023 and hopefully not caused you any disruption. We have been working closely with Aberdeen City Council and the project design team to have the CLT (Cross Laminated Timber) frame designed. The CLT frame is currently being manufactured in Austria where you will have seen the works of the CLT have commenced and hopefully you have enjoyed the build progressing out of the ground. As the frame continues to rise will provide an overview architectural vision of the project.

We have also been working closely with our Supply Chain and have made many contract appointments for the delivery of the project, which is going to involve the co-ordination and management of 76 different work packages.

We have commenced formation of the Muga pitch (Multi Use Games Area) and has been carefully selected through design to maximise playing qualities and experience, including providing a safe and durable environment to meet both school and community requirements.

What to expect in the coming months (Dec – Jan)

- CLT (Cross laminated timber) progression
- External Services duct works.
- Access to Conningham Gardens will have parking restrictions to form new access road effective from 11th of December – 22nd of December 2023 as advised in recent letter from Hatton.
- Masonry sub-structure works to Zone 1.
- Boundary permanent fencing to Southeast area of Harris drive end of December 2023.
- Early January 2024 to enclose Mugga pitch fencing and chap housing development boundary.
